AVM 4.0 Setting up Operating Hours

This manual describes how to create vehicle operating hours to use for private/business mode without a privacy switch installed.

1 SETTING OPERATING HOURS

Setting up operating hours allow you to identify vehicles being used for business or private.

To set up “Operating Hours” click on “Manage” from the main page.



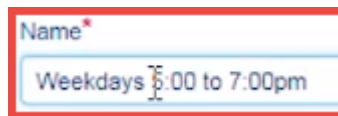
From the here select “Vehicles” and “Operating Hours”.



To create new operating hours, click on “New.” at the top right of the page.



Give your operating hours a descriptive name as in the example below:



Choose “Start” and “Finish” times for each day you want to report.

Once you have selected all the times for the days you want, make sure you click on the “Enabled” radial button for each day and click “Save”.



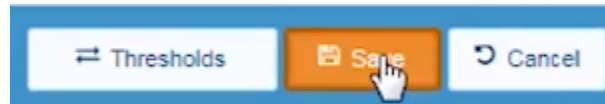

From the details page select the Operating Hours that apply to this vehicle.


